**NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL SAFETY MAINTENANCE WORKS  
A52 between M1 Junction 25 and A1 Barrowby**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential safety maintenance works to several sections along the A52 between the M1 Junction 25 and the A1 at Barrowby.

During our scheme of work, we will resurface several sections of the carriageway, refresh road markings, install high friction surfacing, replace traffic detection loops, and renew bridge joints.

Once completed, all road users will benefit from improved road condition and safety as well as a smoother driving experience.

**When will the work take place?**

This work is due to start on **31 January 2022** and is scheduled for completion in **March 2022**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise inconvenience and disruption to the local community, residents, and road users, we will work between **8pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday**.

The work will be carried out in phases as outlined below.

- Phase 1: Wheatcroft to Gamston
- Phase 2: Wheatcroft to Notts Knight Roundabout
- Phase 3: Queens Drive exit slip
- Phase 4: Priors roundabout to QMC
- Phase 5: Priors roundabout to M1 J25
- Phase 6: M1 J25 to Priors roundabout
- Phase 7: Bingham to Barrowby

Please note that all our planned works are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances, such as clashes with other emergency work on the diversion routes.

## How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and motorists, we will need to use full carriageway closures in phases while we work.

During all road closures we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority. All carriageways will be open as usual outside of our working hours.
