

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(WHATTON FOOTPATH NO.20) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Nottinghamshire County Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make an Order, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:-

No person shall: - Proceed on foot

in the following length of Footpath at Whatton in the Borough of Rushcliffe:-

Whatton Footpath No.20, at the bridge over the River Smite

IT IS INTENDED that the prohibition will apply as follows:-

From Monday, 7th February 2022 until Monday, 28th February 2022 inclusive.

AND NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that during the period of restriction the alternative route will be via Church Street, Old Grantham Road, Dark Lane and Main Street and vice versa.

The prohibition shall apply to enable works to be carried out and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath. It may also apply on subsequent days when it shall be necessary. If the works are not completed within 6 months, the Order may be extended.

The prohibition is required to enable repairs to be made to the bridge over the River Smite, and in respect of the likelihood of danger to the public and damage to the footpath.

THIS CLOSURE WILL ONLY TAKE EFFECT WHEN SIGNS INDICATING CLOSURE ARE DISPLAYED
