It was RESOLVED to accept apologies from Councillor Haslam.

880. PLANNING – to consider the following planning applications for comment.

a) 22/02080/FUL – Proposed loft conversion with rear dormer – The Bungalow/Cottage, Main Street, Aslockton, Nottinghamshire

THE Council had no objection.

b) 22/01925/FUL - Erection of new two storey dwelling - Hedgecroft Abbey Lane Aslockton Nottinghamshire NG13 9AE

The Council RESOLVED to object on the following grounds

- 1 Due to its siting, scale and design, the proposed dwelling would be unsympathetic to the historic character of the surroundings and would have an intrusive impact on the street scene which would cause harm to the character and appearance of Aslockton Conservation Area.
- 2 Due to its siting and scale the proposed dwelling would result in a cramped and over-intensive development with an inadequate sized private amenity space resulting in unsatisfactory level of amenity for future occupants.

881. FINANCE
